NOTICE OF COMING INTO FORCE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 – SECTION 257 THE DISTRICT OF NORTH WEST LEICESTERSHIRE FOOTPATH N59 TUNGSTEN PARK BARDON ROAD COALVILLE PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2021

On 08 May 2024 North West Leicestershire District Council confirmed the above Order without modifications.

The effect of the Order as confirmed will be to **DIVERT** the section of public footpath N59 within the ward of Bardon and the District of North West Leicestershire which extends from the point marked A on the plan, situated at grid reference SK 44267 12929 in a generally Easterly direction for a distance of approx. 149 metres to point B on the plan at Grid Reference SK 44427 12938 as shown on the Order map.

The alternative footpath will instead extend from the point marked 'A' on the plan, situated at Grid Reference SK 44267 12929 in a generally South South Easterly direction for a distance of approx. 3 metres to point C on the plan, situated at Grid Reference SK 44273 12924 then continuing in a generally Easterly direction for a distance of approx. 25 metres to point D on the plan at Grid Reference SK 44290 12924, then continuing in a generally North North Easterly direction for a distance of approx. 8 metres to point E on the plan at Grid Reference SK 44287 12921 then continuing in a generally East North Easterly direction for a distance of approx. 24 metres to point F on the plan at Grid Reference SK 44338 12935then continuing in a generally North North Easterly direction for a distance of approx. 4 metres to point G on the plan at Grid Reference SK 44340 12937, then continuing in a generally North North Easterly direction for a distance of approx. 5 metres to point H on the plan at Grid Reference SK 44346 12942, then continuing in a generally North North Easterly direction for a distance of approx. 47 metres to point I on the plan at Grid Reference SK 44374 12976, then continuing in a generally East North Easterly direction for a distance of approx. 3 metres to point J on the plan at Grid Reference SK 44380 12978 as shown on the Order map.

This order comes into force on the date on which North West Leicestershire District Council certify that the terms of Article 2 of the order have been complied with, but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within six weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to the Act.
